GRANTS VS. DONATIONS

Grants are larger funds for a specific, pre-planned purpose

Organizations apply for grants

Grantees are accountable for using funds as planned

Donations are smaller funds given freely, often via a fundraising campaign

Patrons can donate to a project or to an organization as a whole

Recipients can use the funds as they see fit

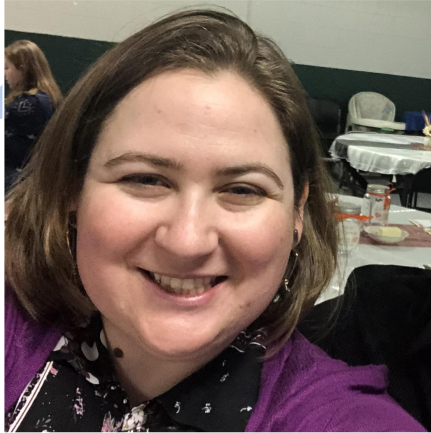
